

# TRIESTE (Italy)




234.493 inhabitants







## Staircase approach vs Housing First


Housing First is an alternative to emergency shelters





## **Housing First Model**

#### Into housing directly from streets or shelters





#### **Main Principles**



House is a basic human right

**Empowerment and self-determination** 

Separation between housing and treatment

Partecipation in the expenses (30% of the incomes)

Multidisciplinary team

Recovery approach

Community engagement

**Regular visits**

## **Key Objectives**



Implementation of the Housing First methodology within Trieste's Municipal Social Service (2020 on)

Provide a **permanent home** to selected people with high support needs, without the need for them to meet any preconditions for eligibility other than **being homeless or in unsafe or inadequate housing** 



#### **Main Activities**



10 apartments to a total of 30 residents

**Meetings with potential clients** 

Signing personal agreements

Access to Emporio della Solidarietà for material aid

**Personnel visits** 

Training and job placement service

**Budgeting and financial mentoring** 

**Community involvement** 



## **Target group**



Single and especially families referred by the social service to the Housing First team for whom other housing projects failed and who are homeless or live in unsafe or inadequate housing.



## **Achievement of objectives**




16 people had achieved a **good level of autonomy** and continued their life path without the support of the project team

362 people supported through **Emporio della Solidarietà**, including 116 minors, 26 elderly people and 14 disabled people.

Currently, work is under way to make the project **a stable and a complementary measure** with the more classic "step-by-step" approach
